This research was fielded in the Baltimore Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) from April 16th to April 21st 2013, and is part of WB&A's established MarkeTrak® quarterly public opinion study. A total of 401 adults were polled (200 via telephone interviews and 201 via an online survey), with a geographic sample representative of the market.



Baltimore MarkeTrak®, along with a companion Washington, DC area survey, piggybacks general interest questions with those of specific clients who share the cost of the study to obtain answers to critical questions. All client data are proprietary and confidential. This study on Health Care Reform was not conducted for any organization.
